## MEN'S BASKETBALL TRAVELS TO CENTRAL MISSOURI LOOKING FOR A NEEDED WIN

**THE GAME:** Truman State University Bulldogs (Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association/NCAA Division II) vs. Central Missouri State University Mules (Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association/NCAA Division II)

**DATE/TIME:** Jan. 24, 2004, 3:30 p.m.

**ARENA (CAP.):** Multipurpose Arena (8,500)

**LOCATION:** Warrensburg, Mo.

**BROADCAST:** Bulldog basketball games are broadcast on KRES 104.7 FM in Moberly, Mo. The games can also be heard over the web at [www.regionalradio.com/html/kres.html](http://www.regionalradio.com/html/kres.html). Sports Director Brad Boyer does play-by-play with commentary from long-time Bulldog announcer, Hank Janssen. The pregame show begins approximately 15 minutes before tip-off.

**TRUMAN (4-12, 1-6 MIAA):** The Bulldogs continue to put a scare into the top teams in the MIAA, but they haven't been able to pull out a much needed victory.

The latest setback came on Wednesday against the No. 2 team in the country. Truman grabbed its first lead of the game with 2:34 remaining, but Northwest Missouri's Kelvin Parker took the game over at that point, helping the Bearcats prevail by a 68-63 score.

The Bulldogs will be in action this Saturday when they travel to Warrensburg to take on Central Missouri. Truman is looking to snap a six-game losing streak and a 22-game road conference skid.

**SCOUTING CENTRAL MISSOURI (12-4, 4-3 MIAA):** The Mules, which went 8-1 in non-conference action, are currently tied for fourth in the conference standings with a 4-3 mark. Central Missouri snapped a two-game losing streak last Wednesday with a 93-86 victory at Missouri-Rolla.

Statistically, the Mules are one of the top teams in the conference. They are third in both scoring defense and scoring offense and second in scoring margin. The team ranks near the top in all

one three-pointer a contest.

Central Missouri's top scorer is Pat Schumacher who is averaging 13.2 points a game. He is second in the MIAA with a .609 field goal percentage and 2.69 blocks and he is seventh with a 7.1 rebounding average. Brian Rhodes averages 10.8 points a game and has a team-high 8.1 rebounding average and 26 steals on the year.

Derek Weber leads the team with 27 three-pointers on the year and puts up 12.5 points a game. Jeremy McFall leads the conference with 5.38 assists and a .922 free throw percentage.

Head coach of the Mules is Kim Anderson. Last season was his first as a collegiate head coach and he led Central Missouri to a 13-15 mark.

**SERIES HISTORY:** Central Missouri owns a 106-65 all-time series advantage over the Bulldogs and a 54-18 lead in games played in Warrensburg.

Last season, the Mules won a pair of close games, winning 66-63 on their home court and 73-71 in Kirksville. The last Truman win in the series was a 58-54 victory at home in 2002. Its last win in Warrensburg was a 68-63 victory back in 1999.

### MOST RECENT GAMES -

#### NORTHWEST MISSOURI-68, TRUMAN-63

The Bulldogs overcame a 19-point deficit to grab the lead, but once again suffered a close loss. Truman fell on Wednesday night to the second-ranked team in the country by a 68-63 score.

The Bearcats' Kelvin Parker scored 17 of his game-high 21 points in the second-half, including eight after Truman had taken its only lead of the game at 58-57 with 2:34 left. His biggest basket came with 43 seconds left when he broke a 61-61 tie with a three-point play after being fouled while converting a layup.

Truman turned the ball over its next possession, leading to two made free throws by the Bearcats' Sky Wilson. The Bulldogs quickly drove down and made a layup to make the score 66-63 and Parker was fouled with four seconds left. Truman had a slimmer of hope when Parker missed the first shot, but he drained the second free throw to seal the Bearcats' victory.

The Bulldogs came out cold from the field in the first-half and quickly fell behind 31-12. They used a 12-2 run to get back into things and were only down 35-24 at the break.

In the second-half, Truman was on fire from the field, shooting 69.6% from the field and hitting six-of-10 from the three-point line. The Bearcats had their largest lead of the half at 46-35, but Truman went on a 13-3 run to tie the ballgame. However, Northwest Missouri was able to hang on down the stretch, handing the Bulldogs another heartbreaking loss.

Truman outshot and outrebounded the Bearcats for the game. However, the Bulldogs turned the ball over four more times, which led to Northwest Missouri scoring 17 points off turnovers, compared to just four for the Bulldogs. The Bearcats also went to line 16 more times and made 12 more charity shots than Truman.

Matt Brock continued his hot-shooting of late for Truman. He led the team with a career-high 18 points, including five three-pointers. Grant Agbo kept his double-figure scoring streak alive

with 12 points. Andy Calmes paced the squad with six boards.

Wilson and Byron Jackson joined Parker in double-figure scoring as both had 12 points. Austin Meyer led Northwest Missouri with four rebounds and tied with Parker for the team-high with three assists.

#### Central Missouri-93, Missouri-Rolla-86 (Jan. 21, Rolla, Mo.)

Central Missouri put five players in double figures as it held off a furious rally by Missouri-Rolla in the final minutes to claim a 93-86 win Wednesday at the Bullman Multi-Purpose Building.

The Mules, who shot 51.9 percent for the game, got 19 points from Brian Rhodes and 18 points from Pat Schumacher, who also finished with 11 rebounds and three blocked shots. Central also got 16 from Jeremy McFall and Reggie Soward -- with Soward doing his damage early and McFall completing the job in the latter stages.

Soward scored 14 of his 16 points in the first half to help Central build a lead as large as 16 points. The Mules led, 41-32, at the intermission, then built it back to a 17-point margin at 69-52 with 11:10 to go.

Central Missouri still led 78-63 with 5:31 to play, but the Miners went on a 19-9 run and closed the gap to five on Ike Muonelo's three-pointer with 57 seconds to go. Missouri-Rolla's Mark Grim then got a steal on Central's next possession and was fouled, but missed both free throws with a chance to trim the lead to three. McFall then finished off the Miners by hitting 6-of-6 at the line in the final 19 seconds.

Jermaine Burks led the Miners with 21 points, while Muonelo was an assist shy of a triple-double as he had 15 points and a career-high 11 rebounds to go with his nine assists.

**HOT SHOOTING HAND:** Prior to the Bulldogs' game against Emporia State, Matt Brock had hit just two three-pointers on the season and was two-of-13 (.154) from beyond the arc.

In the last four games, the sophomore guard has given Truman a huge spark off the bench with 16 three-pointers in 29 attempts (.552). He has also received his most playing time on the year, averaging 20 minutes a game over the last four contests.

appears to be coming around. Over the last four games, the Bulldogs are 57-of-69 (82.6%) from the free throw line, including hitting 81.8% against Missouri Western. Prior to the Emporia State game, the team was shooting just 60.6% from the line.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** The Bulldogs' freshmen class of Grant Agbo, Andy Calmes, Austin Kirby and Adam Ogle continue to put up impressive performance. Those four players have accounted for 43.8% of the team's points and 42.3% of the team's rebounds this season.

Only 17.5% of the team's scoring and 15.6% of the team's rebounding has come from Truman's one junior and two seniors.

**BULLDOGS IN THE MIAA:** In the latest MIAA statistics, Truman ranks fourth in the conference in scoring defense and 10th in scoring offense. Truman was fourth in the MIAA in offensive rebounds and fifth in field goal percentage defense and rebounding margin.

Individually, Grant Agbo was 13th in scoring, 11th in rebounding and 10th in field goal percentage. Adam Ogle was eighth in the MIAA in blocked shots and Andy Calmes was tied for 14th in rebounding.

for the Bulldogs and Ryan Welker has made 12 in a row ... Jack Schrader is 5-10 in his career against Central Missouri ... Kim Anderson is 2-0 in his career against Truman ... the Bulldogs have had more turnovers than their opposition in the last eight games ... Truman shot a season-high 94.7% from the free throw line against Washburn and had single-digit turnovers for the third team on the season.

**AROUND THE MIAA:** Washburn is one of three unbeaten in the country and moved up to 10th in this week's national poll ... Northwest Missouri slipped one spot to No. 2 ... Missouri-Rolla's Ike Muonelo was named the Wilson/MIAA player of the week after averaging 28.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists as the Miners went 1-1 last week on the road.

**1,000 WINS:** The Truman men's basketball program won the 1,000th game in program history earlier this season against Harris-Stowe. This year is the 84th season of Bulldog basketball and the program has an all-time record of 1,001-889 (.530).

**BULLDOG COACHING STAFF:** Jack Schrader is starting his ninth season as head coach of the Truman men's basketball team. Prior to being named the head coach, he served as an assistant coach at Truman for four years under Willard Sims.

In eight years under Schrader, the Bulldogs have made five appearances in the MIAA postseason tournament. He has a 94-142 (.398) career record at Truman and, in 1998-99, led the team to one of its best seasons that concluded with an appearance in the 1998-99 NCAA championship semifinals. Truman claimed the MIAA postseason tournament championship that year and Schrader was named the conference's co-coach of the year and the NABC regional coach of the year.

Prior to coaching the Bulldogs, Schrader coached professional and high school teams all over the world. He was a member of the Arizona State Sun Devils for three years and was drafted by the Phoenix Suns in 1975 and played professionally in Europe.

Assisting Schrader for the fourth consecutive year is Tim Deidrick. Deidrick started his coaching career under former Bulldog head coach Willard Sims in 1992 as a student and graduate assistant. He also coached at Scottsdale Community College (Ark.) and St. Louis Community College before returning to Truman in 2000.

**UP NEXT:** The Bulldogs return to Pershing Arena next Wednesday for a 7:30 p.m. game against Southwest Baptist. The Bearcats, who play Missouri Western on Saturday, are 3-13 overall and 0-7 in the MIAA.

### Central Missouri-66, Truman-63

Truman shot 50% from the field and held the Mules to 32.3% shooting, but Central Missouri forced 27 turnovers and went to the free throw line 17 more times as the Mules came from behind for a 66-63 victory.

The Bulldogs jumped out quickly, scoring the first six points and eventually building a 23-7 lead. Central Missouri chipped into the lead and was down by just nine at half. After Truman scored the first basket in the second-half, the Mules went on a 9-0 run to tighten the game.

The score was tied at 52 when Bret Maxwell scored five straight points to spark a 7-0 Truman run. The Bulldogs lead was three with one minute left but they turned the ball over once and missed three-point attempts the rest of the way.

Central Missouri took advantage by hitting six-of-six from the free throw line for the win.

Truman held the advantage in also every category but free throws and turnovers. The Mules scored 29 of their points off of Bulldog turnovers with 19 of those coming in the second-half. Truman won the rebounding battle 39-36, shot better than the Mules from the field and three-point range and had seven more assists.

Ryan Welker led the team with 11 points and Adam Gloseier was the other Bulldog in double-figure scoring with 10. Aaron Mueller had nine points after hitting three three-pointers while Chip Sodemann had eight point and four assists despite playing just 24 minutes before fouling out. Matt Beran was the leading rebounder with eight.

The Mules were led by Mark DeBaun who had 19 points, 11 rebounds and five steals. Brian Rhodes and Jeremy McFall each had 10 points.

### Central Missouri-73, Truman-71:

A late comeback attempt by the Bulldogs was not enough as their season came to an end with a 73-71 setback to Central Missouri.

The Mules used an early 7-0 run to take a 11-6 lead and Truman would never be able to regain the advantage. With Central Missouri ahead 17-15, it went on 14-0 run to go up 16 points and the Mules ended up going into the lockerroom at half up 42-34.

Truman chipped away at the lead but could never take the lead or tie the game until a Chip Sodemann jumper with five seconds left tied the game at 71. Central Missouri Jeremy McFall took the inbounds pass and went the length of the court before being fouled underneath the basket with 0.5 seconds left. He made both free throws for the win as the Bulldogs could not get off another shot.

Matt Beran had another double-double with 22 points and 10 rebounds. Jiri Mikl just missed a double-double with 12 points and nine rebounds. Sodemann added 12 points, three rebounds, five assists and two steals.

Central Missouri was led by McFall with 17 points and Brian Rhodes who added 16. Dwight Williams had a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds.

## GRAND VALLEY STATE-69, TRUMAN-53
