Week At-a-Glance:

With four straight shutouts now in the book, the Truman women's soccer team will look to keep up the defensive intensity with two matches this week-end. The Bulldogs (6-2-2, 5-1 MIAA) host Missouri Western in the final match of a five-game homestand on Thursday afternoon before traveling for the first time in three weeks to face Southwest Baptist.

The Bulldogs have kept opponents scoreless for more than 365 consecutive minutes, dating back to Sept. 12. In that dominating stretch, Truman has out-shot its foes 79-22 (36-8 on goal), while also taking 24 corner kicks.

Freshman forward Olivia Hayes has been a key component of the offensive surge, tallying five of her MIAA-leading seven goals over the past four contests.

Entering the week, Truman is three points clear of Nebraska-Omaha for the conference lead, though the Mavs have played one less MIAA match. A trio of schools - Southwest Baptist, Northwest Missouri and Central Missouri - are all six points back of Truman.

Bulldog Coaching Staff:

Mike Cannon is in his 17th season as the program's head coach, having compiled a 220-78-29 overall record at Truman. He has guided the purple and white to eight (of ten) MIAA championships and has reached the NCAA tournament seven times.

He is assisted by Martin Clayes, who is in his second season at Truman as a member of the coaching staff following a four-year stint as a player on the men's soccer team.

Scouting the Opposition:

Missouri Western (4-6, 2-4 MIAA)

After starting the season 2-5, the Griffons have won two of their last three - including an overtime loss in their last outing.

Jessica Martin (6g, 3a) and Abby Widrig (4g, 3a) provide most of the offense for MWSU, who has scored 16 goals on the season. Joyce Endicott and Jenna Weis have split time in goal for the Griffons this season, with Endicott posting all four wins and three shutouts.

Jeff Hansen is the Griffons' head coach, and he is 11-51-6 in four seasons.

Southwest Baptist (5-2-1, 3-2 MIAA)

Nearly exactly opposite from MWSU, the Bearcats started the season with four wins and a draw before falling in two of their last three contests.

Always known for a potent offense, this year's SBU bunch hasn't let up, as the Bearcats average more than two goals per game. However, unlike past SBU squads, the scoring is more distributed this time around, as Shannon Roher (4g), Jaymye Ross (3g) and Kelly Isaac (3g) have all found success up front. Megan Link has allowed just ten goals in eight contests, posting three shutouts along the way.

Rob Podeyn is the first-year head coach of the Bearcats.

In the MIAA:

- The Bulldogs rank in the MIAA's top-2 in shots (16.50; 1st), assists/game (1.80; 1st), goals allowed (8; t-2nd), and GAA (0.53; 1st). They are also first in corner kicks taken with 50.

- Individually, Olivia Hayes is tied for first in goals scored with seven, aided by a recent hot stretch of five goals in the past four games. Her four game-winners are also a conference-best.

- Senior Isabel Gaeta and junior Beth Bystrom are tied for third with three assists each.

- Sophomore Jayne Grisham boasts the conference's second-best GAA at 0.80 and is tied for the top spot in shutouts with four.

Quick Kicks:

- If fans are noticing something odd about the MIAA standings so far in 2009, it would be the lack of draws. Through 24 conference matchups, there hasn't been a single tie, and only two contests have gone to overtime. MIAA teams have only been a part of five draws total this season, with the Bulldogs leading the way with two.

- With her 69th minute goal last Thursday, senior Katie Reuck etched her place in Bulldog history by climbing into the program's all-time top-10 in goals scored. She scored her 18th career goal, tying her with Robyn Mortenson (2003-2006) for 10th all-time. Next in line is Melissa Miller (1998-2002), who is ninth with 19.

- The current four-match shutout streak is the longest for Truman since a similar run in 2007. The last time the Bulldogs shut out at least five straight opponents was in 2004 - a six-match run from Oct. 17 to Nov. 7.

- Who scores first has served as the tell-tale for Truman this season, as the Bulldogs are 6-0-1 when tallying the first goal but are 0-2 when falling behind 1-0.

- The Bulldogs will not play at a neutral field until potentially the NCAA tournament, as all four non-conference matches in 2009 were either true home or road contests.

- The Bulldogs bring a 14-season streak of winning 10 or more games into the 2009 campaign and are just four wins away from extending that to 15.

Up Next:

Truman will knock off two of its final three regular season home contests next week with a pair of key battles. The Bulldogs will face the MIAA's pre-season favorite, Central Missouri, for the first time in 2009 on Thursday afternoon before finishing up the season series with SBU on Homecoming Saturday, Oct. 10.
